Our Summer topic was 'Outdoor fun/Summer festivals'










We found out all about staying safe in the sun and put on our sun cream and enjoyed the paddling pools and the big playground and the tyre park.

















I am so proud of each one of the children as they have finished their EYFS year. They have all made lovely progress and developed their confidence and tolerance.






We have been learning to engage, share and communicate as our main focuses this year.


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
We have been learning through the topic, Happily Ever After, we have loved exploring stories and creating our own fairytale creatures. Look at all the fun we have had this term!













#### Story time and phonics



We learnt about day and night, used programmes on the interactive board and ordered days of the week.


























On Bastille Day we painted the French flag and built Eiffel tower models and tasted French foods.
