


# Ten Things to Do With a Toilet Roll Tube


## 1. Make a Rocket

Three, two, one.... lift off! Turn a toilet roll tube into a fantastic rocket using card and any other craft materials that you have at home.



## 2. Toilet Roll Tube Stamps

Cut a toilet roll in half and fold it into a shape such as a heart, square or triangle. Carefully dip the surface of the shape in some paint and make some lovely, colourful prints!




## 3. Be a Queen for the Day!

Paint a toilet roll tube in silver, gold or your favourite colour. Cut the top of the tube into a crown shape. Make two holes at the base of the tube and thread some thin elastic through them. You have a lovely crown!




## 4. Whacky Glasses

Cut a toilet roll into halves or quarters. Cut out some card to make a frame for your glasses and tape it all together. Decorate your glasses with a whacky design!



## 5. Toilet Roll Wild Animals

Turn a toilet roll tube into a wild animal such as a monkey, lion or elephant. Add paint, card, googly eyes and any other craft items you have at home. Why not make a whole jungle scene?




## 6. Toilet Roll Unicorns

Paint a toilet roll tube in your favourite colour and draw on some eyes. Use tape to attach some ears and a horn and some brightly coloured wool to make the mane and tail. What adventures will your unicorn get up to?




## 7. Toilet Roll Plant Pots

Cut a toilet roll in half. Cut four flaps in the bottom of each half about 1.5cm in length. Fold the flaps upwards to form a base and secure with a piece of tape. Fill your pot with soil and plant a seed. You can plant the toilet roll and seedling straight into the ground as the cardboard will be biodegradable.



## 8. Toilet Roll Castle

If you have several toilet roll tubes, why not make a fairy tale castle? Paint each tube and leave to dry. Cut out some windows, a doorway and battlements and make cones out of card for the turrets. Glue or tape all of the toilet roll tubes together. This beautiful castle is fantastic for role play!



## 9. Toilet Roll Tube Windmill

Paint a toilet roll tube in your favourite colour. Make a cone out of card for the roof. Look at a picture of a windmill – can you see the sails that go around in the wind? Cut four sails out of card and attach them to your windmill using a split pin. Why not make a whole toilet roll tube town?



## 10. Toilet Roll Tube Monsters

Let your imagination run wild and create some scary toilet roll tube monsters! Paint your toilet roll tube with a bright colour and use craft materials such as wool, googly eyes, buttons, card or felt tips to add hair, teeth and eyes.
